

## *Administrative Assistant Bruce Lenell DeArmon Sr*



Pastor Bruce DeArmon Sr. was born in Gary, Indiana, in September of 1972 and is the seventh child of the late Deacon George DeArmon Sr. and Mother Sarah DeArmon (Huggins).

His studies in Instrumental Music and Electrical Engineering led him through Maintenance and Technical Operations careers for over 18 years. In 2015, he began his career as a Funeral Director while attending the American Academy McAllister Institute to receive a Bachelor's in Mortuary Science. He is a graduate of Rasmussen University with an associate degree in business management.

Overton Shekinah Glory District, 2nd Vice Chairman of the Board of Superintendents and Administrative Assistant to Bishop Fred Willis Washington.
